Week 1: We will have fun drawing self-portraits and doing lots of painting for the next 8 weeks. We will start out talking about what we look like and what makes us different from others. Students will use cray-pas colors to draw themselves however they see themselves to be. Funny thing is I always imagine myself with PINK hair.

Week 2: Students will continue with another interesting way to draw their self-portraits. Today students will outline their reflection using a mirror, clear sheet of plastic, and sharpies. Afterwards they will use glue and tissue paper to frame their abstract self-portrait.

Week 3: This week the students will start out sponge painting on a sheet of paper. While the paintings are drying they will draw themselves using white crayon and black paper. Then they will cut out their portraits and glue them onto their painted backgrounds.

Week 4: I have to admit there have been times I have written "Super Mom" under job title when filling out my kids forms for various activities. That's how I see ME, "SUPER MOM". I will be asking the kids to think about their super powers then have them draw themselves as their cape crusader and then paint them using water colors.

Week 5: I always start the year with some sort of papier mache project. Students will use newspaper, cardboard tubes and tape to make a statue of themselves.

Week 6: This will be a messy week; we will be making papier mache, kitchen cabinet style, by mixing flour, glue, water, and newspaper strips.

Week 7: Now that their statues are dry they will paint them and add yarn for hair and I will have model magic on hand if they would like to make something to go along with their statues; like a soccer ball.

Week 8: I always leave week 8 open to finish up any projects. However never fear, if we stay on track I will come up with a fun ME, MYSELF, and I project that is sure to be fun.
