In this workshop, students will be provided with all of the materials needed to learn about and build circuits. Using supplies in the innovation center, students will get a chance to create a product that uses LEDs and sounds, and can be manipulated with switches, buttons, and potentiometers. Participants will learn the basics of how electrical currents flow and what works and what doesn't when it comes to building our own circuits. Students will be given to bring their own creativity to designs and will walk away with products to bring home at the end of their five weeks.
