UNITY launches on Saturday, September 30, 2017 in conjunction with Unity Day of the Ashland Farmer's Market and will run through October 1st.

In June of 2016, UNITY, an interactive public art project, was created as a response to the divisiveness and negative rhetoric in American politics.

Created to raise consciousness about the labels we give ourselves and others and explore how those labels both support and limit building interconnected, interesting communities.

UNITY is a larger-than-life structure comprised of circular arrangement of poles in a field. Each pole is labeled with an identifier. For example, "I'm a parent," "I speak English as a Second Language," "I identify as LGBTQ."

With yarn, participants tie to each pole with which they identify. A canopy of interconnectedness forms as more people participate.
