

Meals update from Superintendent Adams March 16, 2020

Starting Thursday, March 19, the Ashland Public Schools will be offering PreK-12 students the opportunity to pick up Grab and Go meals, covering breakfast and lunch for two days. The meals can be picked up from the Ashland High School cafeteria. Signs will be posted in the back of the building with directions. Students will need their individual pin numbers for identification. The schedule for meal pick up is as follows:

1. **Thursday, March 19, 11 am -1 pm**
2. **Monday, March 23, 11am -1pm**
3. **Wednesday, March 25, 11 am -1 pm**
4. **Friday, March 27, 11am -1pm**
5. **Monday, March 30, 11am -1pm**
6. **Wednesday, April 1, 11 am -1 pm**
7. **Friday, April 3, 11 am - 1pm**

Unfortunately, we cannot accept food items, but should anyone want to donate financial resources, checks should be made out to the Ashland Public Schools Nutrition Services and sent to 87 W.
