The Learn to Skate program is divided into three separate zones based on skating ability. Classes are instructed in coordination with USA Hockey Development Program and our continued partnership with Pro Ambitions Hockey Inc. Zones 1 and 2 are instructed by our Development Director, while Zone 3 is instructed by Pro Ambitions.

- **Zone 1 (Red)** First time skaters are taught how to get up, stand and take steps without assistance.
- **Zone 2 (Yellow)** After learning the basics, skaters progress to skating drills involving balance and body control. The drills are designed to prepare skaters to take full strides and stop.
- **Zone 3 (Green)** Once the skater has exhibited the ability to skate and stop, advanced instruction on edge control is emphasized to further the skaters confidence to skate at full speed.

All registrants receive a Demons Youth Hockey practice jersey and a certificate of achievement at the end of their session.

All players are required to wear a HECC certified helmet with a cage, skates, elbow pads, knee pads and hand protection (hockey gloves, winter gloves or mittens). In addition, we recommend hockey pants be worn as your player progresses to Zones 2 and 3 as speed increases and further protection may be desired.

The Learn to Hockey program is instructed by Pro Ambitions Hockey Inc, in coordination with our Development Director. Players are instructed on the proper positioning and form while skating with a stick, further development of edge control and introduced to playing with a puck. Fundamental skills including stick handling, passing and shooting are also established at this level. Players can expect to develop a foundation for progression to the Mosquito Cross Ice program.

All registrants receive a Demons Youth Hockey practice jersey and a certificate of achievement at the end of their session.

Full hockey gear is required HECC certified helmet with a cage, skates, elbow pads, shoulder pads, knee pads, athletic protector/short, socks, pants gloves, stick.
